I am a firm believer that everyone has their own perfect swing. This swing is based on your body type and athletic ability. I will not try and “fit” you into a canned swing approach or mold you after one specific player. I will analyze your current golf game, assess your goals as a player, and create a practice program to help achieve your goals.

By combining my background as a player, with my experience teaching and coaching, we can maximize your abilities as a player and help you achieve your goals.

Working on your short game (75 yards in) is a great way to see the most improvement in your game.

Use Of Technology

As a late generation tech boomer, I believe technology plays a tremendous role in improving your game. I do a lot of work with a local company called Zenolink (www.zenolink.com) that uses 3D software for swing analysis. I video tape every lesson as this is a great way for students to reinforce proper technique. Each student will get a copy of their video lesson to review at a later date. Video, Audio, How We Learn and Retain Information

The information below is from a recent study:

How we register information:

-83% visual

-11% audio

How we retain information:

-21% audio

-32% visual

-52% what we hear AND see

-70% what we hear, see AND discuss

Why is this important to what I do with you? In most golf lessons, you receive a lot of verbal information, and some visual information from the pro. He or she will demonstrate what to do, and will tell you if you are doing it. The missing piece to this is actually seeing yourself swinging the club and doing the recommended drills. This allows you to make the connection between what is told to you (verbal from the pro), how to do it (visual from the pro) and how you do it (visual of yourself). You will also be able to watch your lesson at any time on your own computer (you will need Windows Media Player). This is why the use of video lessons is SO important to each student, and why I use video for every lesson we do.
